Round 1 Determining 4-digit Heading — 7016

Fact: The product is a molded glass subway wall tile measuring approximately 11.75 by 2.82 by 0.5 inches intended for use on walls.

Round 2 Determining 6-digit Subheading — 7016.90

Fact: The item is a subway wall tile made of molded glass.

Coverage: Subheading 7016.90.10 explicitly provides for paving blocks, slabs, bricks, squares, tiles and other articles of pressed or molded glass.

Exclusion: Subheading 7016.90.50 provides for other miscellaneous articles of the heading, which is not applicable since tiles are specifically named in 7016.90.10.

Round 4 Determining 10-digit HTS Code — 7016.90.10.50

Decision: 7016.90.10.50 at 10-digit under GRI1. Candidates (sorted): 7016.10.00.00 — Glass cubes and other glass smallwares, whether or not on a backing, for mosaics or similar decorative purposes; 7016.90.10.10 — Bricks and blocks; 7016.90.10.50 — Other. Key evidence (verbatim facts quotes): "glass mosaic subway wall tile", "tile is made of molded glass", "intended for use on walls".

In [N271979](#), dated 2016-08-08, CBP classified a molded glass wall tile measuring approximately 11.75 inches by 2.82 inches by 0.5 inches in subheading 7016.90.1050, HTSUS, as other pressed or molded glass tiles of a kind used for building or construction purposes.

Support for 7016.90.10.50 under GRI 1 is reinforced by [N271979](#) (Aug. 8, 2016), where CBP classified a molded glass wall tile of essentially identical dimensions (11.75" x 2.82" x 0.5") in 7016.90.1050 as a pressed/molded glass tile of a kind used for building or construction purposes. Although [N271979](#) notes an opaque white back coating and thin-set mortar installation, those details do not alter the controlling characteristics here (single molded glass wall tile for building use), so 7016.90.10.50 remains appropriate.
